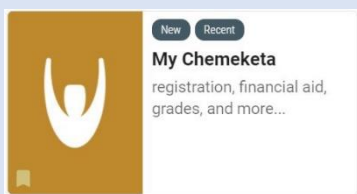

Book a Virtual Tutoring Session

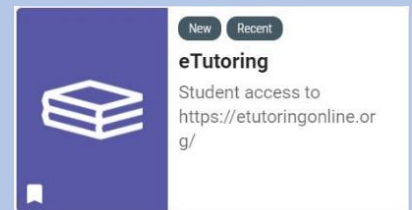
